WHAT DO I DO IF THE PUBMED CENTRAL REFERENCE NUMBER (PMCID) HAS NOT BEEN ASSIGNED YET?

I. If a manuscript was submitted on your behalf by the Rockefeller Library and a PubMed Central reference number is not yet available, include the NIH Manuscript Submission System reference number (NIHMS ID) instead. The Principal Investigator and the RU Library (Carol Feltes, extension 8909) should have this number.

II. If you publish in a journal that deposits all NIH-funded final published articles in PubMed Central (PMC) without author/the Rockefeller Library involvement, a PMCID may not be assigned until several weeks after publication. During this time, please signify compliance with the policy by indicating "PMC Journal - In Process" at the end of the citation.
